

## Retama Parkinsonia flexicaule

Retama is an attractive south and west Texas native with graceful, airy foliage and fragrant yellow flowers. It grows north to Georgetown, west to Arizona, down to South America.

Retama is often found naturally in poorly drained sites. This is probably because it can withstand a variety of soils. It also is extremely drought tolerant, making it a wonderful candidate for water-wise landscapes and parking lot plantings. Retama also has a high salt tolerance so it a good choice for coastal conditions.
