



Canary Island Date

Phoenix Canariensis

The Canary Island Date Palm is a large slow-growing palm. Because of its size, it looks best in commercial and large residential landscapes. The trunk can be as big as four feet in diameter. Its orange and yellow ornamental fruits ripen in the summer. Canary Island Dates do well in parking lots or in roadway medians. Canary Palms have been successfully grown in areas with air pollution, poor drainage, compacted soil, and drought. Avoid planting where it can be bumped by autos as damaged trees are susceptible to Ganoderma rot. They are easily pruned for walking, biking, or driving clearance.
