



Chinese Fan Palm

Livistona chinensis

We have found Chinese Fan palms to have an amazingly steady growth rate. Although they grow somewhat slow, each planting has grown at exactly the same rate in the field; the palms look like clones. This makes them a great choice anywhere you want to maintain the same height. We also love seeing them planted in groups of 3 or 5.

The leaves are about 6' in diameter with the segments split about 2/3 into the frond. This gives them a weeping appearance. The fronds keep their olive green color a long time.

Chinese Fans are only cold tolerant as far north as San Antonio - and then you may want to plant them in a protected area. They are available booted or shaved.
