



Mule Palm

Butiagrus naboronnandii

A cross of a Pindo Palm (*Butia capitata*) and the Queen palm (*Syagrus romanzoffiana*) they are drought and salt tolerant. They grow up to 30'-35' in full sun or partial shade. These palms are extremely cold hardy, up to 14 degrees F, less than a pindo but more than a queen. Their leaves are gracefully curved and create a draped look as they grow.

Like all hybrids, mules are infertile. Only on rare occasions, will they produce seed. This makes Mule palms a very tidy plant in landscape.
